Museum Auction Features Wood-Turned Bowls Created from the Eagle & Phenix Dam

Wood-turned crafted bowls made by renowned artists Philip and Matt Moulthrop will be available for purchase at The Columbus Museum. The bowls, made of longleaf pine, are created from the 19th-century Eagle & Phenix Dam and some contain traces of history such as original wooden nails. These are the only bowls made from the wood.

The silent portion of the auction will open during the Museum's annual Master Circle Dinner, December 5. The public can view the bowls and make silent bids on-site during regular Museum hours Tuesday, December 6 through Thursday, December 8. A portion of the bowls will be selected for a live auction, which will be held Thursday, December 8, 6-8 p.m. Light refreshments will be served during the event. Proceeds from the auction will benefit the Museum.
